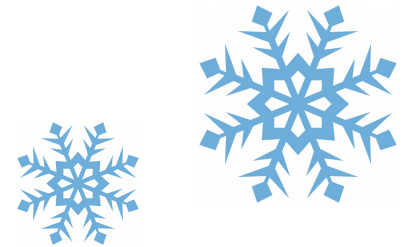
## Tumble and Twirl
